<u>RECORD OF THE DECISION</u>	
<p>a) The issue</p> <p>Under section 192 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, an applicant can ascertain whether any change of use or operations which are to be carried out in, on, over or under land are lawful. This can be done by applying for a certificate of lawfulness.</p> <p>This application is seeking to ascertain that the proposed building operations outlined in the application are lawful (without the need for a formal planning application) by virtue of Schedule 2, Part 1, Class B of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (the “Order”) together with a concurrent change of use from a dwelling house into a house in multiple occupation as permitted by Class L of the Order.</p>	
<p>b) The Decision</p> <p>The Certificate be issued for the proposed building operations and change of use</p>	

REASON FOR THE DECISION

The assessment is a matter of law, fact and degree. The applicants have submitted proposals that satisfy the requirements of the 2015 Order
