## RECORD OF THE DECISION

### a) The issue

Private Sector Housing assists owners to improve their homes through the provision of energy efficiency grants and other forms of financial assistance. To assist often vulnerable residents with the delivery low carbon heating alternatives and other energy efficiency measures the services of a heating contractor and solar installation company are required. The procurement will allow the service to signpost residents to a suitable contractor and enable the service to better manage delivery of essential low carbon heating and solar systems

### b) The Decision

To proceed with procuring a heating contractor through the EEM procurement framework.

## REASON FOR THE DECISION

This relates to the Installation of renewable heating and hot water systems Associated Works as part of HUG 2, and future Energy Schemes Scope to cover Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough as well as North Warwickshire Borough Council for privately owned housing.

This is an award of a new contract due to the previous Aaron Service contract ending with no mutual agreement to extend, therefore this new Delegated Decision is required.
