Good afternoon Keith,

Apologies for the delay I have been on and off with annual leave the last two weeks. Below is an update on the two relating projects.

Weddington Growth Project which is to build a new upsized sewage pumping station at Weddington Road adjacent to the existing site has been pushed back. This is due to upcoming Water Industry National Environment Programme targets in the area aligning to the Weddington SPS and Sewer Network. Design activities for the project will begin again next year. Our current outline design for the new pump station and new pressurised rising main will now need to be revised to incorporate WINEP, likely the proposed site will need to be increased further in size. Construction of the new site will not be until April 2025 onwards.

Weddington Flood Alleviation Project design activities have halted. This is due to a current lack of funding from WCC which is required under a Partnership Scheme for works on non STW assets. There is an open Non STW watercourse and culvert which requires over a £1.1m investment for reduce the surface water flood risk at Church Lane, upsizing of the receiving STW surface water sewer can be upsized once rectifications are completed under a scheme, however, we cannot justify the spend to construct the chosen solutions without sufficient WCCFRM funding for improvements to their assets. We are continuing to liaise with WCC in the hopes of a Partnership Scheme to enable us to deliver the chosen solution to reduce flood risk.
