

## **Borough Plan Adoption Statement**

The Borough Plan 2011-2031 was adopted on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019, including the main modifications recommended by David Spencer, the Planning Inspector who was appointed to carry out an independent examination of the Borough Plan. The council have also included additional modifications, which taken together do not materially affect the policies that would be set out in the document if it was adopted with the main modifications but no other modifications.

Anyone aggrieved by the Borough Plan can make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The grounds on which an application can be made are that the document is not within the appropriate power, and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The period within which the application must be made is before the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the adoption date, which will be 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
